

Summer Family Fun Day

In Milton, Wisconsin

Start your day with a tour of the Milton House, a National Historic Landmark and recognized part of the National Network to Freedom, located at 18 S. Janesville Street. This hexagonal stagecoach inn is the only Underground Railroad site in Wisconsin that you are able to tour. The tour includes an underground tunnel that fugitive slaves used to move between the basement of the Milton House and the cabin behind the Milton House.

Reward your children with a trip to the **Goodrich Square Splash Pad**, 404 Parkview Drive. The splash pad is 4,000 square feet of outdoor aquatic fun that the whole family can enjoy! Eat your picnic lunch at the park or order carry-out from one of **Milton's local restaurants**.

After the splash pad, go to the **Cone Zone**, 444 W. High Street, for a soft serve ice cream treat or **Red Rooster**, 613 W. Madison Avenue, for a hand dipped ice cream cone. Across the street from the Cone Zone is Schilberg Park that features football and baseball fields, walking path, and a great playground. The family could also go hiking on the **Ice Age Trail** at **Storrs Lake Wildlife Area** or ride on the **Glacial River Bike Trail** along State Highway 26 both located on the fringe of the City limits. The **Rock River Trail** also runs through Milton.

End your family fun with a delicious meal at **Anchor Inn**, 718 E. State Road 59, Edgerton, or **Rosati's**, 723 E. Ellendale Road, Edgerton. Then rent a pontoon boat from Anchor Inn and take it for a spin on Lake Koshkonong, one of Wisconsin's largest lakes. The **World's Largest Culvers** is located near Anchor Inn if you want to have dinner there or end the day with some frozen custard.
