Subject: Public Hearing, Discussion, and Possible Action Regarding Ordinance #467
Amending the Comprehensive Plan Land Use Map along North Janesville Street.

Summary

Commensurate with the transfer of land between the Milton School District and the City of Milton, the City will need to amend its Comprehensive Plan to reflect the new boundary line between Milton East Elementary School and South Goodrich Park. Currently South Goodrich Park is designated as Parks and Recreation and Milton East Elementary School is designated as Community Facilities on the City's Official Land Use Map. With the change of the boundary line, the Map will need to be amended to show the new 1.4 acres of land being transferred to the School District as Community Facilities as well.

Background

Per State Statutes, any amendment to the Comprehensive Plan must be approved by the Plan Commission and a Public Hearing must be held in front of the Common Council. Ordinance #467 effectuates the change necessary to the City's Land Use Map.

Recommendation

Following the Public Hearing, the City Administration Recommends the Common Council adopt Ordinance #467 amending the Comprehensive Plan's Land Use Map along North Janesville Street.
