

PRELIMINARY PUBLIC WORKS RESOLUTION #2020-11

Preliminary Resolution Declaring Intent to Exercise Special Assessment Powers Under Section #66.0701 & 66.0703, Wisconsin Statutes

RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Milton, Wisconsin;

1. The Common Council hereby declares its intention to exercise its power under Section #66.0701 & 66.0703, Wisconsin Statutes, to levy special assessments upon property within the following described area for benefits conferred upon such property by said improvement:

SANITARY SEWER LIFT STATION, SEWER MAIN, SEWER INTERCEPTOR MAIN, AND APPURTENANCES INSTALLATION

Property	Service Area
Lift Station #12 Service Area	Lift Station Service Boundary Map Attached. Starts at Lift Station #12 on Parkview Drive and Includes All Properties Within The Area Noted on the Map.

2. The amount assessed against any parcel shall not be greater than the benefits accruing thereto from said improvements.
3. The assessment against the parcel may be paid in cash upon adoption of the final assessment resolution per City Council adopted lift station policy, per Sec 66-241 (7) of City Ordinances.
4. The Director of Public Works is directed to prepare a report consisting of:
 - a. Plans and specifications for said improvements.
 - b. The entire cost of the sewer lift station project, sewer main, interceptor sewer main and appurtenances.
 - c. The estimate against each parcel of property.
 Upon completing such report the Director of Public Works is directed to file a copy thereof in the City Clerk’s office for public inspection.
5. Upon receiving the report of the Director of Public Works, the Clerk is directed to give a Class 1 notice of a public hearing on such report as specified in Section #66.0701 & 66.0703, Wisconsin Statutes. (The Clerk is further directed to prepare as part of such notice a small map showing the general boundary lines of the proposed assessment district.) The hearing shall be held at the Council Chambers in the City Hall at a time set by the Clerk in accordance with Section #66.0701 & 66.0703 Wisconsin Statutes.
