Start your day 20 minutes outside of Milton at [Busy Barns Adventure Farm](#), W7675 US Hwy 12, Fort Atkinson. There are so many adventures waiting for your family: feeding farm animals, tractor drawn hayrides, large straw bale climb, and so much more!

When you are done exploring Busy Barns Adventure Farm, drive in to Milton to enjoy a delicious lunch at one of our many [local establishments](#).

After lunch, head over to [Hawk's Orchard](#), 9034 N. Serns Road, to purchase some delicious apples. There are many varieties that are ripe at different times of the season. Then go to [Meyer's Farm Market](#) to pick a pumpkin or other produce in season, go through their corn maze, and check out their retail shop.

If you would like to bring your adventure indoors, considering touring the [Milton House Museum](#), a National Historic Landmark and recognized part of the National Network to Freedom. This hexagonal stagecoach inn is the only Underground Railroad site in Wisconsin that you are able to tour. The tour includes an underground tunnel that fugitive slaves used to move between the basement of the Milton House and the cabin behind the Milton House.

The newly renovated [Milton Public Library](#) is another great indoor option for the whole family. The children's area features a museum quality store front play area, reading areas, and hands-on learning opportunities. The Spark Lab is available to increase your children's imagination and an interest in science, technology, and art.
